Terms and Conditions

Participant Responsibility:

By participating in the Living Hope Bible Church Family Annual Camp, all attendees acknowledge and accept responsibility for their personal safety and well-being. Participants must conduct themselves in a manner that does not endanger themselves or others.

Supervision of Minors:

Parents or legal guardians are responsible for the supervision and behaviour of their children throughout the camp. It is essential to ensure that children are always accompanied by a responsible adult and adhere to the instructions given by camp organisers and staff.

Beach Activities:

Some camp activities may take place close to the beach. Participants engaging in beach-related activities, such as swimming or water sports, do so at their own risk. It is crucial to follow safety guidelines, be aware of the water conditions, and take appropriate precautions to ensure personal safety.

Medical Conditions and Allergies:

Participants are responsible for disclosing any known medical conditions, allergies, or dietary restrictions that may affect their participation in camp activities. This information should be provided during the sign-up process to allow camp organizers to make appropriate accommodations and take necessary precautions.

Waiver and Release:

Prior to participating in the Living Hope Bible Church Family Annual Camp, all attendees (or their legal guardians) will be required to sign a waiver and release form. This form acknowledges the voluntary nature of participation and releases Living Hope Bible Church, its staff, and volunteers from any liability for personal injury, loss, or damage incurred during the camp.

Code of Conduct:

Participants are expected to adhere to a code of conduct that promotes a safe and respectful environment for everyone. Please refer to the Code of Conduct below.

Emergency Procedures:

In the event of an emergency, participants should immediately follow the instructions provided by camp organisers and staff. Emergency contact information provided will be used to communicate important updates or contact designated emergency contacts if necessary.

Photography and Media:

Our media team may capture photographs, videos, or other media during the camp for archival purposes. By participating in the camp, attendees grant Living Hope Bible Church the right to use such media without further consent or compensation.

Camp Changes and Cancellations:

Living Hope Bible Church reserves the right to modify or cancel camp activities, sessions, or the entire camp in unforeseen circumstances. Participants will be notified promptly of any changes or cancellations and provided with alternative options, if applicable.

Code of Conduct

1. Love and Kindness - "Above all, love each other deeply, because love covers over a multitude of sins." (1 Peter 4:8)

 - Extend grace and forgiveness to those who may offend or make mistakes, just as Christ has shown us.

 - Resolve conflicts in a peaceful and respectful manner, seeking reconciliation and understanding.
3. Honouring God's Word - "Your word is a lamp for my feet, a light on my path." (Psalm 119:105)
 - Uphold the authority of God's Word and engage in Bible study and teaching sessions with attentiveness and openness.
 - Seek to apply biblical principles in our thoughts, words, and actions, aligning ourselves with God's will.
4. Integrity and Honesty- "The integrity of the upright guides them." (Proverbs 11:3)
 - Act with integrity and honesty, conducting ourselves in a manner consistent with our Christian faith.
 - Speak truthfully, avoiding gossip, slander, and deceitful behaviour.
5. Purity and Modesty - "Above all else, guard your heart, for everything you do flows from it." (Proverbs 4:23)
 - Maintain purity of heart and mind, avoiding immoral thoughts, words, and actions.
 - Dress modestly, respecting ourselves and others as temples of the Holy Spirit.
6. Servant-heartedness- "For even the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve." (Mark 10:45)
 - Embrace a spirit of servant-heartedness, seeking opportunities to serve and bless others during the camp.
 - Show compassion, generosity, and humility, imitating the example of Christ.
7. Good Stewardship - "So whether you eat or drink or whatever you do, do it all for the glory of God." (1 Corinthians 10:31)
 - Practice good stewardship of the camp facilities and resources, being mindful of cleanliness and responsible usage.
 - Avoid wastefulness and engage in sustainable practices that honour God's creation.
